



Dimming the Keypad Lights

The dial pad on your CapTel phone lights up to make it easy to see the keys. In some cases, you may want to dim the keypad lights, for example if you prefer a dark room when you sleep. You can set the keypad lights to turn off automatically. When keypad lights timeout is selected (keypad lights off), the dialing pad lights turn off after approximately 30-60 seconds of inactivity. The keypad lights remain on whenever you are using the phone.

The way you turn off keypad lights depends on which model CapTel you use.

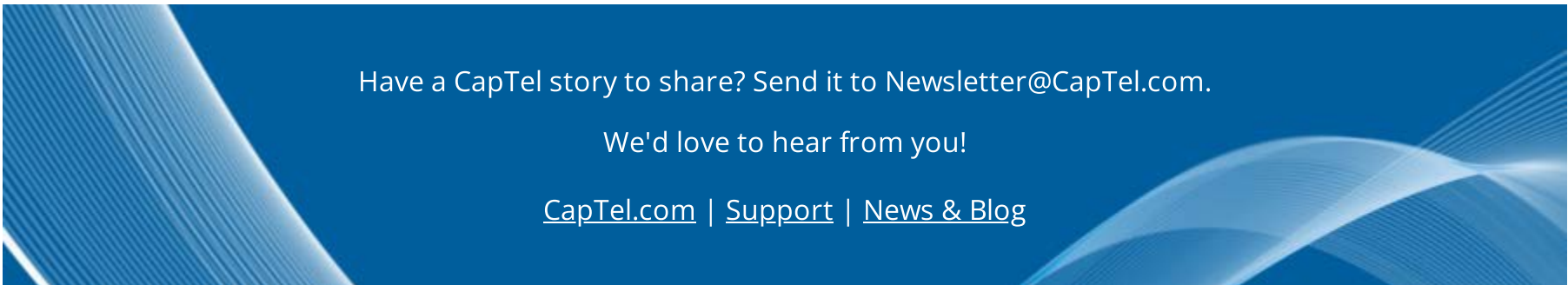
