



## How The Captions Scroll – You Decide!

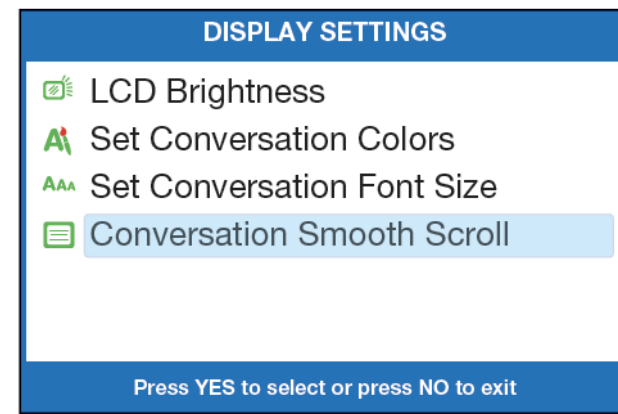
You can control how captions come up on your CapTel display screen: either appearing word-by-word as each word is captioned or by scrolling line-by-line in a continuous movement. The way you change the scrolling method depends on which CapTel model you have:

### CapTel 2400i



On the display screen, touch Settings ► General Settings ► Smooth Scrolling. Touch the scrolling option that you prefer. CapTel saves your selection.

### CapTel 840i/880i



In the Options menu, select Settings ► Display Settings ► Conversation ► Smooth Scroll. Choose between smooth scrolling ON (line-by-line) or OFF (word-by-word). Press Yes to save your choice.

**Note:** The scrolling method you select will appear during your next call, and will remain in effect until you change the setting again.

## CapTel in the Community

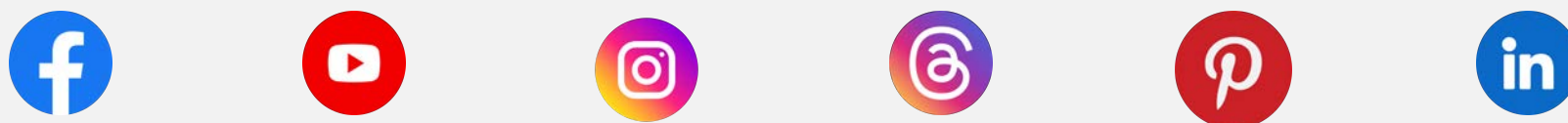

Automatic speech recognition software generates captions of what the other party to the call says, and, in certain circumstances, a live communications assistant may be included on the call to make needed corrections and/or add call details. The captions are then sent to the phone. There is a cost for each minute of captions generated, paid from a federally administered fund. No cost is passed on to the CapTel user for using the service.
